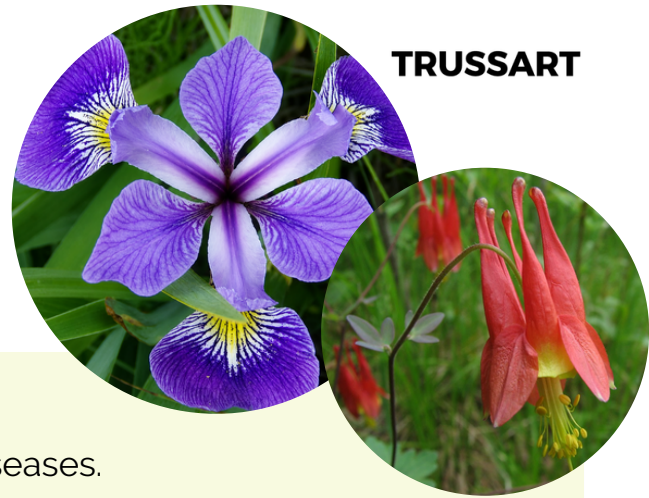


Native Perennials

Sustainable allies for vibrant and resilient landscapes



Adapted to our climate

Hardy and resistant to frost, drought, and local diseases.

Low maintenance

Once established: requires little watering, minimal fertilizing, and very little upkeep.

Support biodiversity

Attract bees, butterflies, birds, and other essential pollinators.

Environmentally resilient

Help stabilize soil and support better water management.

Support the food chain

Essential for many native insects and birds.



Polygonatum pubescens
Ideal for woodland spaces and shaded landscapes.



Penstemon hirsutus
An excellent choice for dry and challenging landscapes.



Physostegia virginiana
Fast and vigorous growth.



Agastache foeniculum
Highly attractive to pollinators with long-lasting blooms.



Aquilegia canadensis
Low maintenance and pollinator-friendly. A valuable nectar source for hummingbirds.



Iris Versicolor
Floral emblem of Québec. Represents the richness and diversity of our natural landscapes.
